

In addition, there was an increased demand for supply of equivalent replacement UV lamps and quartz sleeves for existing UV equipment made by other manufacturers; some of which had gone out of business and left customers stranded without a source for annual lamp or quartz sleeve replacement. So, over the years, Atlantic Ultraviolet Corporation® has expanded the manufacturing of **STER-L-RAY®** germicidal lamps and **CRYSTAL CLEAR™** Quartz sleeves and currently offers a wide range of equivalent replacement lamps and quartz sleeves for just about every make and model of germicidal ultraviolet equipment on the market.
